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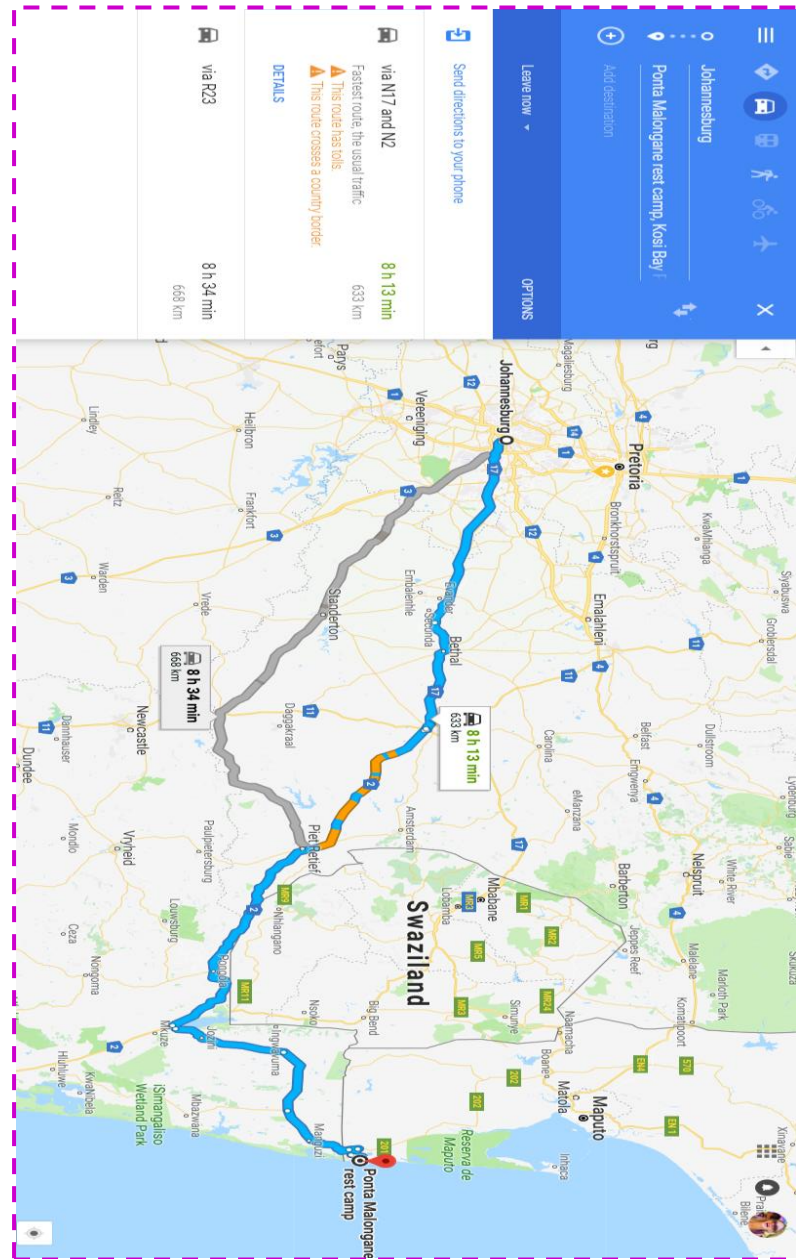

THE JOURNEY

The drive there, most definitely forms part of this adventurous journey, which makes up the sum of the experience called “Mozamboogy”.

Please note: Enter Mozambique through the Kosibay Border Post not through Komatipoort

PLANNING YOUR TRAVEL TIMES

It is however rather important that you **plan your journey**, for the simple reason that the border post at Kosi Bay is not open 24 hours a day, which forms part of the charm, it is a quaint border post that opens at 08h00 in the morning and strictly adheres to closing at 17h00 – be sure not to arrive late, and miss the border. It is important to keep in mind that the first part of your journey is usually without issue, and traveling speed is average. The chances are very good that you might be met with a lot of mist along the way, especially in the regions of Ermelo and Piet Retief, which by default will slow down your traveling speed, and adding traveling time onto your journey. In the surrounding areas of Jozini, you’re travelling speed gets slowed down due to “villages” that you drive past, in these areas the average traveling speed slows down to 60 km per hour, and you will encounter speed bumps, vast amounts of cattle, goats and lots of pedestrians, most of which are school children. After Pongola your general traveling speed is slower due to speed restrictions and single lane roads.

Make sure not to miss the turning towards Jozini Dam (you need to travel over the dam wall) – if you go wrong here, you are likely to end up in Swaziland which is also nice, but will make you miss an entire day of Mozamboogy Fun!

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED AND A LIST OF EMBASSY / CONSULATE DETAILS

Do not forget your passport!

Should you be traveling with a South African Passport you DO NOT NEED A VISA. But there are still two important factors to keep in mind.

1. Your passport needs to be valid for MORE THAN 6 MONTHS after date of entry into Mozambique.
2. There needs to be a MINIMUM of 2 BLANK PAGES in your passport, if not, it is too full.

If you are travelling with a **NON-SOUTH AFRICAN PASSPORT** you **DO REQUIRE A VISA**, which document can ONLY BE PRE-APPLIED for. The process is rather quick, but don't wait too long. Should you require a visa, please send an e-mail to visa@mozamboogy.com providing me with your FULL NAME AND SURNAME as it appears in your passport, together with your PASSPORT NUMBER. I will then send you (via e-mail) a Letter of Invitation, which is to be taken with to the Embassy. The only time a VISA can be issued at the BORDER POST, is when you come from a country where they have NO MOZAMBICAN EMBASSY. If you live in a country that has an Embassy or Consulate they WILL NOT issue you a visa at the border post.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR PASSPORT WAS STAMPED (DOUBLE CHECK THIS YOURSELF) IT NEEDS TO FIRST BE STAMPED BY THE SOUTH AFRICAN AUTHORITIES (BUILDING ON THE LEFT), THEN YOU GO THROUGH THE BORDER POST, AND WALK TO THE BUILDING ON THE RIGHT-HAND SIDE (WHITE TEMPORARY / PARK HOME OFFICE UNITS) THERE YOU MAKE SURE TO DOUBLE CHECK THAT YOUR PASSPORT HAS BEEN STAMPED BY THE MOZAMBIQUE OFFICIALS. DOUBLE CHECKING THAT IT HAS IN FACT BEEN DONE STAYS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.

HOW TO BOOK A BORDER TRANSFER

Those without 4X4's, bakkies or any four-wheel drive vehicle, must make use of a border transfer to get to Ponta Malongane. The resort is situated 14km from the border post. Here is the Mozambique Mobile Number of Thembi, she is the Front of House lady at the resort. You simply send her a WHATSAPP message (well in advance) – it is important that you tell her your name, your current location (then she knows how far away you are approximately) and for how many people you would require a Border Transfer. She will respond via WHATSAPP to you. Should you have problems a local mobile number will be posted a couple of days prior to the festival on Facebook the event page and the Mozamboogy group, where you could reach one of the organizers. It is easiest to just send WHATSAPP messages or email us when we are there. There is NO SOUTH AFRICAN cellphone reception – and roaming is not a good idea. 😊

Please note it is very important that you pay the driver of the vehicle in cash (South African Rand) when you get into the car. Please do not pay the drivers for the return trip – not in advance, it is not advisable. It is furthermore very important that you double check that all your luggage was loaded in to the vehicle when the pick you up and the same goes for the point of drop off. **Your belongings stay your responsibility.**

They are not too strict with regards to luggage restrictions (within reason).

It costs approximately R120 per person per one-way trip for a Border Transfer. (keep this in mind for your return trip).

WHERE TO PARK YOUR CAR AND HOW MUCH IT COSTS

When you get to the Kosi Bay Border Post (just before the actual border control point, there is a small car parking lot on your left. You simply park your vehicle here – it is perfectly safe. They charge approximately R40 per day per car. This needs to be paid in CASH upon your departure. So, keep some money hidden away in the car, because when you return you might be out of money, there is NO ATM or CARD FACILITIES at the border post.

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DOCUMENTS NEEDED AT THE BORDER POST FOR VEHICLES AND TRAILERS ETC.

What documents are required at the border if we bring our boats, quad bikes, jet skies, etc?

You will need the registration papers (original or certified copies) for the above, including any trailers. License papers are usually accepted.

When taking your 4x4 vehicle over the border you need to make sure of the following:

1. That you have a valid up to date driver's license with you
2. That your vehicle's license document is up to date
3. That you informed your insurance company that you

WHAT DO I NEED TO PAY AT THE BORDER?

You will need to pay approximately R230 per vehicle for the compulsory third party insurance that allows you to drive in Mozambique. This is valid for 30 days. The third-party insurance is extremely important so make sure that you obtain it.

WHAT CAN I TAKE ACROSS THE BORDER?

Any meat must be vacuum packed and is at the discretion of the border officials. There are limits for different types of alcohol.

VERY IMPORTANT INFO REGARDING CHILDREN COMING TO THE BOOGY

Please take note that minors need to have **UNABRIDGED BIRTH CERTIFICATES** this is non-negotiable. Both parents of the child need to be present, if not, various affidavits need to be obtained beforehand.

ABOUT MALONGANE, THE RESORT AND THE LOCAL COMMUNITY

Situated in southern Mozambique, just 14 km north of the South African border, Ponta Malongane is best known for its supreme diving sites and excellent fishing.

A location that is worth any distance of travel, a memorable place, a campsite (1 kilometer in length) that runs parallel to the ocean, with a campsite lined with a remarkable collection of beautiful trees, home to the many different types of animals living here, ranging from birds, monkeys and even bush babies. It is a place of serenity, the campsite runs alongside the pristine beachfront, unspoiled and preserved, just like mother nature intends it to be. It is said to be one of the magical spots on our great earth, where 2 lei lines cross. The energy vibrates positively, if you look around one can truly feel the magic of this venue.

PARKING

Guests must park in the designated areas only; we request that you do not park on the grass. If there are any problems, please contact the reception or the resort's management.

BRAAI

It is strictly forbidden to braai on the grass. No fires are allowed on the beach without the permission of the resort manager.

FLORA AND FAUNA

Guests should not damage or remove fauna and flora in and around the resort. Wood or charcoal can be obtained in the shop during working hours. No pets are allowed in the resort.

REEFS

If anyone is reported to management or found to be abusing the reefs, fish, plant life, removing things from the reefs etc., she/he will not be allowed to dive.

DRIVING ON THE BEACH

Driving on the beach is strictly prohibited. The resort reserves no right to grant any permission whatsoever to drive on the beach.

CASUAL STAFF

Can be employed to assist you. Check at reception for available help. Please ensure that you discuss and agree on a wage that you will pay as the casuals are not part of the Malongane team and therefore are not responsible for them. NO casual workers may work between 18H00 and 06H00. Wages vary between R20-00 to R25-00 per day per casual.

SECURITY

Although Ponta Malongane has security on duty 24 hours a day, management does not take any responsibilities for any goods stolen or damaged during your stay there. Ponta Malongane reserves the right of admission at all times.

CURRENCY USED AT MALONGANE / ATM'S / CREDIT CARD FACILITIES

The local currency is Meticals (mc), but there is no need for you to exchange your money – they are very happy to accept South African Rand, as well as US Dollar.

There is NO ATM at the resort in in the local village, the closest ATM available is in Ponta da Oura. The resort makes use of card facilities (but take note that the card facilities are occasionally offline. The long and the short of it: Bring enough cash!

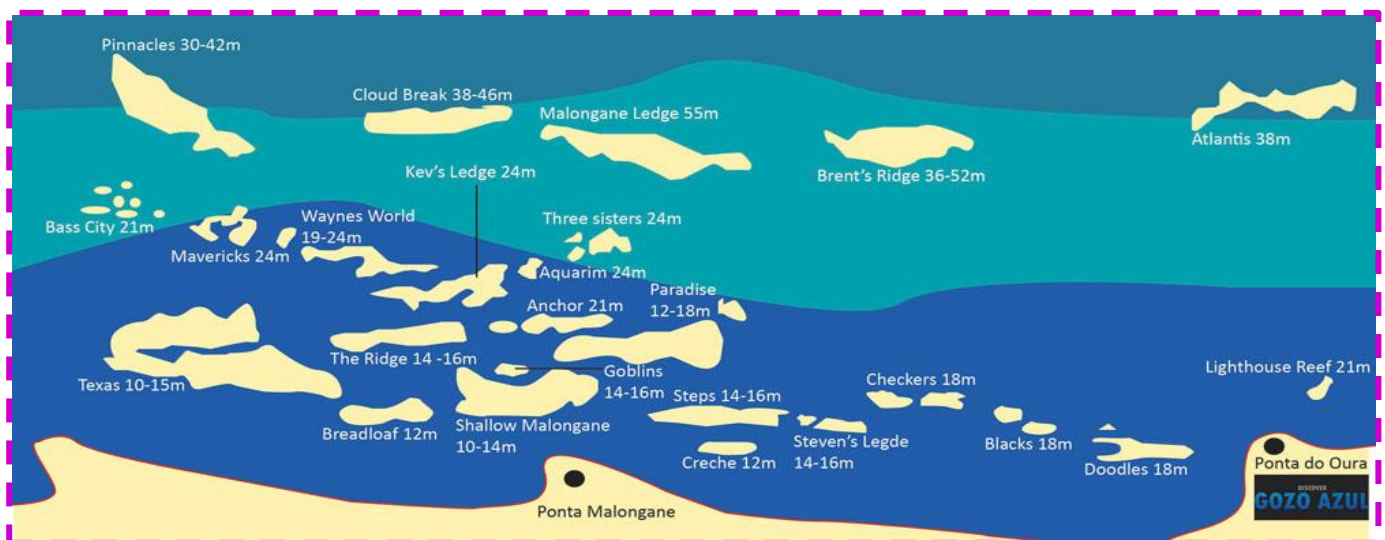
FISHING

SNORKELING

As a PADI Resort, we can offer more than 30 dive reefs for your viewing pleasure! Ranging from a shallow 8m (for the not so confident) to advanced dives around 50m. You can stay close to home with our closest reef only 300m offshore or join us further afield about 7 Km's.

See the Indian Ocean at its best as you explore under the surface at Ponta Malongane and surrounding areas. The dive centre at *Complexo Turistico da Ponta Malongane* is run very professionally and have numerous dive options for you to choose from. In this underwater world of astonishing beauty, you will find a variety of coral and barrier reefs located just 1-2 meters of the coastline. Diving in this beautiful location is a memorable experience indeed, through the professional assistance of the helpful crew from the Dive Centre at the resort. No matter your qualification, due to the vast quantities of reefs you can be a novice diver or go for something a lot more challenging by exploring one of the reefs – allowed only to Advanced divers.

THE DIVE REEFS AROUND MALONGANE



INFORMATION REGARDING GEAR RENTAL, DIVE PLANNING AND SO FORTH

All water sport activities at Parque de Malongane is run from the dive centre in the Dive Camp, situated in the southern part of the resort just 30 meters from the beach. It is a stylized double story wooden complex, with self-catering kitchen, dining area, bar, small pool, a medical room, kitting up decks and compressor station, which offers you 232 Bar air-fills.

Dive Planning takes place at the Dive Centre of the resort, every day between 17h00 and 18h00. Please make sure to attend those if you wish to get onto one of the dives. The resort has well serviced boats, and a skipper who knows his way around the ocean, making launching (most of the times) a comfortable experience. Scuba gear can be rented from the dive centre. All divers will be charged R100 reef tax for the weekend.

A minimum requirement is an **Open Water Qualification** which will allow you to dive at Malongane. As mentioned above, for the **Advanced Divers**, the Indian Ocean boasts several spectacular reefs accessible only to the more Advanced Divers.

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For those who have no prior diving qualifications, **D.S.D. (Discover Scuba Diving) courses** are presented at the dive centre. It is a one-day course – after completion you would be able to go for an open water dive in the ocean, closely assisted by one of the dive instructors from the dive centre.

OPEN WATER SITES

Bread Loaf (10 – 12m): If you want to explore and see pinnacle rocks, sand gullies, plate coral and a variety of fish life especially rays and scorpion fish then this is the reef to experience

Creche (10 – 12m): This dive is ideal for student & novice divers or those people who would like to dive a shallow reef. It has been named creche due to the abundance and wide variety of juvenile fish that can be seen.

Doodles (15 -17m): A fantastic dive with a massive variety of marine life. Octopus, mantis shrimp, potato bass, rays, honeycomb moray eels and game fish.

Paradise (12 -18m): For the chance to experience paradise under the sea – superlative corals, moray eels, tremendous gullies and overhangs await you, not to mention the wide variety of reef fish.

Ridge (12 – 16m): Here is the chance to discover a ledge, which is approximately 4m high with plenty of magnificent corals (soft and hard). Also discover the cave on this reef. The marine life is plentiful, and you have a chance to spot the turtles and kingfish. (Quick Fact: a sea turtle is called “Tartaruga” in Portuguese)

Shallow Malongane (12 – 14m): The opportunity to see all types of corals, grand turtles and large crayfish. On the southern part of this reef there are many gullies and caves that await your investigation.

Texas (12 – 16m): As the name indicates this is one of our larger reefs. For the adventurous diver, central to this reef is a large gully with swim through, overhangs and arches. Turtles, scorpion fish, rays, eels and soft corals can also be found.

ADVANCED SITES

Maverick’s (25 – 28m): One of Malongane’s deeper dives. In the middle of the sand is an awesome pinnacle rock that is 20m across & 30m long with its residents. Find honeycomb morays, smaller morays, leaf fish and other sea wonders.

Three Sisters (21 – 25m): The 3 sisters of the sea are 3 pinnacle rocks about 50m apart. A prospect not to be missed where there are huge amounts of fish life – black cheek moray eels, honeycomb morays, lionfish and large rays are just some of the examples.

Anchor (18 -21m): Not only do you get the joy of exploring the anchor on the southern end of Kev's Ledge that gave this reef its name but also 2 parallel ledges with an abundance and variety of reef fish.

Pinnacles (28 – 42m): Imagine being able to dive on the edge of a continental shelf with sharks Hammerheads, Zambezi and Dusky not to mention large game fish and manta rays. Summer is the ideal time to dive this reef.

Bass City (20 -25m): Bert is famous throughout the waters of southern Mozambique and is in residence at Bass City. There are 4 other large potato bass on the 5 outcroppings of rock that make up this reef, but Bert is the only one who will come and swim with you. Come and discover **other sights**.

Riana's Arch (18 – 24m): Your dream of swimming through an awesome arch with a rich and spectacular variety of fish is possible on the northern side of Kev's Ledge.

Kev's Ledge (21 – 24m): For the inquisitive person the many and varied crevices of a 6m rocky ledge is heaven and is yours to explore with its wide and varied marine life. It is like a wall dive.

OCEAN SAFARI'S

Prefer being above the water? Join us on an Ocean Safari, if you're lucky the dolphins will even pay us a visit. There are approximately 150 resident Bottlenose dolphins along our coast here in Southern Mozambique. Our ocean encounters are not only limited to bottlenose dolphins. we frequently encounter Whale Sharks, Manta Rays and even Humpback Whales. With one of our facilitators you can learn all about them and the other marine life we see on our trip during this non-intrusive interaction.

Unlike many other parts of the world we are very fortunate in that we can still interact with the big marine species on a personal level. Come and join our well informed and friendly facilitators on an ocean safari and have a chance to enjoy a memorable experience with whale sharks, bottlenose dolphins, manta rays and humpback whales with babies during their migration. If the conditions are right, you will even get the chance to jump in the water and view these magnificent creatures up close and personal.

Snorkeling gear is available at the Dive Centre to hire if you don't have your own.

FISHING

A spear fisherman's paradise! Fishing is one of our most popular activities at Complexo Turistico da Ponta Malongane. We have provided a specific cleaning area in the camp for those deep-sea fishermen who travel with their own boat. Get the job done quicker with our experienced staff who are more than willing to help so you can get back to relaxing. Please ensure that all boats comply with the necessary safety measurements before launching. All oil/ fuel spills must be cleaned up as soon as possible. One of the most popular activities here at Malongane with fishing charters available on request. Should you wish to go deep-sea fishing you can bring your own boat and equipment. It is also possible to fish straight off the point and the beach of Malongane. Malongane is a superb place for spear fishing. A fish cleaning area is provided outside the dive camp – please use it. Also note that this is where your boat should be warmed up and cleaned.

PLEASE NOTE: NO BOTTOM FISHING IS ALLOWED

By law a fishing license is required in Mozambique – please ensure you have it in place before launching.

Also note you need a license when targeting bill fish.

SNORKELING

See the Indian Ocean at its best as you explore under the surface with Complexo Turistico Da Ponta Malongane. The rocks and rock pools in front of the dive centre are perfect to explore.

In this underwater world is a variety of coral and barrier reefs located just 1-2m off the coastline. We think they are some of the best snorkel spots in Mozambique.

Can't decide? We have a full range of Aqualung snorkel gear available to rent in our shop, so you can decide when you arrive. For a true experience to remember there is the option of Snorkeling off one of our boats to reach some of the shallower reefs. For information, speak to one of our helpful staff members at the dive centre.
