

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Organisers and/or the venue(s) reserve the right to refuse admission or eject a ticket holder for behaviour likely to cause damage, injury, nuisance, or annoyance or for failure to comply with the reasonable requests of the management.
2. The Organisers reserve the right to search all persons and personal property via bag searches upon entry, or at any given time during the event. They will refuse admission to or eject from the venue, any person who refuses to be searched by a steward, member of security or venue representative.
3. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel this event at any stage, if deemed necessary, or if circumstances arise outside their control. They also reserve the right to alter or change the program and line-up without prior notification.
4. Persons attending the event are responsible for their own valuables. None of the Organiser, nor will the venue(s) be held liable for any loss or damage to personal property brought to the venue(s).
5. The Organisers shall not be liable for any loss, damage, cost or expense,
6. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse anyone entry to the venue(s) at their discretion and any person who fails to comply with instructions from a steward or other person acting on behalf of the Organisers may be ejected. In addition, anyone found to be causing damage to the venue(s), the venue infrastructure, causing harm to any other person at the venue, behaving in an illegal, anti-social or aggressive manner, appearing to be under the influence of drugs or in breach of these conditions will be ejected and may be reported to the police.
7. Any person found to be selling illegal substances will be ejected from the event.
8. You consent to be included in any photography, film and/or sound recordings of the festival or its surrounds and for these recordings to be used by us for any future Festival marketing and promotional purposes.
9. Entry may be refused if tickets are damaged or defaced in any way or are not purchased through an authorised point of sale. If a fraudulent ticket is presented the matter will be referred to the SAP services.
10. In the event of request for ticket transfer to another person, the event organiser requests assistance to transfer the ticket from the current ticket holder to the new ticket holder. This ensures the new ticket holder that he or she has indeed purchased a valid ticket.
11. Should circumstances arise that you are unable to attend the event, the event organiser will only refund the ticket holder 50% of the amount paid, this is only applicable if the ticket or booking is cancelled 30 days (approximately 1 calendar month) prior to the event. ONE MONTH PRIOR TO EVENT *Take

note, this point is NOT VALID FOR THE FEAST OF ST. VALENTINES, due to time restraints.

12. Should you cancel your booking anywhere between 1 day and 29 days (about 4 weeks) prior to the event we do not refund any amount paid to us,
